

Troparion Tone 1

(Resurrection)

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure body, Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. The powers of heaven therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of Life: "Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ! Glory to Thy Kingdom!// Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou Who lovest mankind!"

(St. Mary of Egypt)

The image of <u>God</u> was <u>truly</u> preserved in thee, O <u>Mother</u>, for thou didst take <u>up</u> the <u>Cross</u> and <u>fol</u>low Christ. By so <u>doing</u>, thou <u>taughtest</u> us to disregard the flesh for it <u>passes</u> away; but to care in<u>stead</u> for the <u>soul</u>, for it is im<u>mor</u>tal.//
Therefore thy <u>spir</u>it, O <u>holy</u> Mother Mary, rejoices with the <u>ang</u>els.
