Matthew 4:18-23; Matthew 4:25-5:12

Saints of the Day:

On the second Sunday after Pentecost, each local Orthodox Church commemorates all the saints, known and unknown, who have shone forth in its territory. Accordingly, the Orthodox Church in America remembers the saints of North America on this day.

Although it is a relatively young church, the Orthodox Church in America has produced saints in nearly all of the six major categories of saints: Apostles (and Equals of the Apostles); Martyrs (and Confessors); Prophets; Hierarchs; Monastic Saints; and the Righteous. Prophets, of course, lived in Old Testament times and predicted the coming of Christ.

Among those we commemorate today are Innocent, Enlightener of North America, Peter the Aleut, Patriarch Tikhon, Herman of Alaska, and Alexis of Wilkes Barre to name just one in each of these categories, though many of the North American Saints can be listed in more than one of these groups. Each is a shining example of the faith we are called to share with this nation continuing their work in living and teaching the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Also commemorated today are the martyrs Leontius, Hypatius and Theodulus at Tripoli in Syria; Venerable Leontius of the Far Caves at Kiev and Venerable Leontius the Hagiorite.

Troparion and Kontakion of the Day

Tone 1Troparion(Resurrection)

When the <u>stone</u> had been sealed by the <u>Jews</u>, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure <u>bo</u>dy, Thou didst <u>rise</u> on the third day, O <u>Sa</u>vior, granting <u>life</u> to the world. The <u>powers</u> of heaven therefore cried to Thee, O <u>Giver</u> of Life: "Glory to Thy Resur<u>rec</u>tion, O Christ! <u>Glory</u> to Thy <u>King</u>dom! Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou Who <u>lov</u>est mankind!"

Tone 8 Troparion (All Saints of America)

As the <u>bountiful harvest of Thy sowing of salvation</u>, the lands of North America <u>offer to Thee</u>, O Lord, all the saints who have <u>shone</u> in them. By their <u>prayers</u> keep the <u>Church</u> and our <u>land</u> in <u>abiding peace through the Theotokos</u>, <u>O most Mer</u>ciful One!

Tone 1Kontakion(Resurrection)

As <u>God</u>, Thou didst rise from the tomb in <u>glo</u>ry, raising the <u>world</u> with Thyself. Human <u>na</u>ture praises Thee as God, for death has <u>van</u>ished. Adam exults, O <u>Mas</u>ter! Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage and <u>cries</u> to Thee:// "Thou art the Giver of Resurrection to <u>all</u>, O Christ!"

Tone 3 Kontakion (All Saints of America)

Today the <u>choir</u> of Saints who were pleasing to God in the lands of North A<u>mer</u>ica now stands before us in the Church and invisibly prays to <u>God</u> for us. With them the Angels <u>glo</u>rify Him, and all the Saints of the Church of Christ keep <u>fes</u>tival with them; and together they all pray for <u>us</u> to the Pre-e<u>ter</u>nal God.


