26th Sunday after Pentecost Prophet Zephaniah

December 3rd, 2023

Assigned Readings:

Ephesians 5:9-19 Luke 18:18-27

Saint of the Day:

The Holy Prophet Zephaniah was the ninth of the twelve minor prophets. Born on the mountain of Savarat and of the tribe of Simeon, he lived and prophesied in the seventh century before Christ, in the time of Josiah the pious king of Judah, and was a contemporary of the Prophet Jeremiah. With his great humility, pure mind and constant striving after God, he was found worthy of seeing into the future. He foretold the day of wrath of God and the punishment of Gaza, Ashkalon, Ashdod, Ekron, Ninevah, Jerusalem and Egypt. He looked upon Jerusalem as 'a filthy, polluted and oppressing city ... her princes with in her are like roaring lions; her judges are evening wolves ... her prophets are light and treacherous persons; her priests have polluted the sanctuary, they have done violence to the Law.' Foreseeing the coming of the Messiah, he cried out with rapture: "Sing, O daughter of Sion; shout, O Israel; be glad and rejoice with all thy heart, O daughter of Jerusalem!" This seer of secrets and mysteries went to his rest in the place where he was born, there to await the general Resurrection and his reward from God.

Troparion of the Resurrection – Tone 1

When the <u>stone</u> had been sealed by the <u>Jews</u>, while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure <u>bo</u>dy, Thou didst <u>rise</u> on the third day, O <u>Sa</u>vior, granting <u>life</u> to the world. The <u>powers</u> of heaven therefore cried to Thee, O <u>Giv</u>er of Life: "Glory to Thy Resur<u>rec</u>tion, O Christ! <u>Glo</u>ry to Thy <u>King</u>dom! // Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou Who <u>lov</u>est mankind!"

Troparion to St. Nicholas – Tone 4

The truth of things revealed you to your flock as a rule of faith, an icon of meekness and a teacher of abstinence. You thus reached the heights through humility and wealth through poverty. O Holy Hierarch Father Nicholas, // pray to Christ God for the salvation of our souls.

Kontakion of the Resurrection – Tone 1

As <u>God</u>, Thou didst rise from the tomb in <u>glory</u>, raising the <u>world</u> with Thyself. Human <u>na</u>ture praises Thee as God, for death has <u>van</u>ished. Adam exults, O <u>Mas</u>ter! Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage and <u>cries</u> to Thee:// "Thou art the Giver of Resurrection to <u>all</u>, O Christ!"


Kontakion to St. Nicholas – Tone 3
