Assigned Readings:

Galatians 1:11-19 Matthew 2:13-23

Saints of the Day:

The Holy Prophet-King David, Saint Joseph the Betrothed, and Saint James the Brother of the Lord are commemorated on the Sunday after the Nativity. In Jerusalem, there was a feast of the Jews of Hebron celebrated on December 25 or 26 in honor of the Old Testament Patriarch Jacob. Later on, the Christians substituted Saint James for Jacob, and then the commemoration of the Brother of the Lord became associated with his ancestor King David. St. James was the first-born son of Joseph the Betrothed, and after Our Lord's ascension became the first bishop of Jerusalem. He presided over the first council held there and recorded in Acts. Eventually, he would give his life for the faith as a martyr in approximately 63 AD. St. Joseph cared for the Theotokos and the Christ child until he reposed on natural causes before Our Lord began his earthly ministry. King David is the great king of Jewish tradition, a victorious military leader, prophet, and a psalmist.

In time, Saint Joseph was linked with Saints David and James. Obviously, James and Joseph being related are of the same lineage, and in time their descent from the Davidic line incorporated the King David in the commemoration of the family of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. They are now celebrated together on the Sunday following the Feast of Nativity and before January 1st. If no Sunday falls in this period, because both fall on Sunday themselves, this commemoration is celebrated on December the 26th.

Tone 5 - Troparion (Resurrection)

Let <u>us</u>, the faithful, praise and <u>wor</u>ship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the <u>Spir</u>it, <u>born</u> for our salvation from the <u>Virgin</u>; for He <u>willed</u> to be lifted up on the <u>Cross</u> in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead // by His glorious Resurrection.

Tone 4 – Troparion (Feast)

Thy Nativity, O <u>Christ</u> our God, has shone to the world the light of <u>wisdom!</u> For by it, those who <u>wor</u>shipped the stars, were taught by a star to a<u>dore</u> Thee, the Sun of <u>Right</u>eousness, and to know Thee, the <u>Or</u>ient from on high.// O Lord, <u>glory</u> to Thee!

Tone 2 – **Troparion** (*Righteous Ones*)

Pro<u>claim</u> the wonder, O <u>Jo</u>seph, to David, the <u>an</u>cestor of God; thou hast <u>seen</u> a Virgin <u>great</u> with child; and thou didst give glory with the <u>shep</u>herds; thou didst <u>wor</u>ship with the <u>Magi</u>, and didst receive the news from the <u>Angel</u>. // Pray to <u>Christ</u> God to <u>save</u> our souls!

Tone 3 – Kontakion (*Righteous Ones*)

Today godly <u>David</u> is <u>filled</u> with joy; Joseph and James <u>offer</u> praise. The glorious crown of their kinship with Christ fills them with <u>great</u> joy. They sing praises to the One ineffably <u>born</u> on earth,// and they cry out: "O Compassionate One, <u>save</u> those who <u>hon</u>or Thee!"


Tone 3 – Kontakion (Feast)
